### A NOTE FROM PASTOR SANTIAGO

September 2020

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As I wrote the date at the top of this page, it suddenly occurred to me that at the end of this month, I will have been at Trinity in Circleville for a year. WOW! That time went by quickly. I think about arriving here last October 1, with the focus of working with you as to prepare to call a new pastor. I had never done an interim ministry before, so I was not completely sure of what to do.

But as I write these words, I am still surprised and a little astonished at all that we have shared in the past 12 months. What an amazing journey it has been; one that we all know has been full of unexpected challenges and events. Yet, in the midst of it all, the Holy Spirit was present and active in so many ways through the work of so many people.

And that truth, my friends, speaks well for Trinity as you continue the journey that brought me here last fall. The Holy Spirit is supporting the congregation as Trinity moves forward in faith. And I know this because of two very simple facts.

As October 1 comes closer, I am still not completely sure of what 'will need to be done.' But I do know, that whatever challenges come our way the people of Trinity Lutheran Church will

face them with confidence and faith in Jesus, as they continue to do God's work while they continue to "Come and See—Go and Tell.
